

2026 WSPHC General Show Rules www.wsp hc.org

Pre-Entries—A pre entry constitutes an entry that has been processed online with all the information complete. If not attached to the online entry, registration papers & all memberships must be presented to the secretary at the time of entry. All APHA and AQHA Papers and memberships must be uploaded on line to be considered a pre entry. Geldings may not show with Stallion papers. All Breed, CHAMPS and Leadline horses do not require proof of registry. The office fee shall be charged at time of entry and is non refundable. **NO FAXES OR MESSENGER** Rule SC-175

Post-Entries—A \$25 one time post entry fee will be added if entries are received after the entry date. Post entry fee does not apply to pre-entered horses who add classes at the show.

APHA Membership—the rule state that all exhibitors must be current members of APHA: with the exception of All Breed, Champs and lead line classes which are not approved by APHA. Amateurs and Novice Am Exhibitors must present current year APHA Am or Novice Am card OR complete an application for same and return to the show secretary before entry in any class. Amateurs and Novice Amateurs are only allowed to show horses currently registered in their name. Rule Am-020

Masters Exhibitors classified as Master Amateur Exhibitors are allowed to exhibit multiple horses in group classes Rule AM-085

Adds and Scratches—Scratches may only be made through the on line app and must be at least three classes prior to the class you are scratching. All other scratches will be charged. All closed accounts will not receive a refund. You must add your classes for each day online at the show app.

Stall Reservations—Stalls are not guaranteed or assigned if not done in line with complete payment. Groups wishing to be stabled together **MUST PAY FOR ALL STALLS**. Please upload a stall list form with everyone wishing to be stabled together. No phone reservations. Stalls must be vacated and left in a reasonable manner. Any paraphernalia left in stall assigned to you shall constitute a \$100.00 fine. **Stall fees are non refundable.**

Tack Stalls – Tack stall fee cannot be split among multiple entries. One person within the group will pay for the tack stall & settle up with their group

Refund of Entry—Refunds are only granted if an official Veterinary slip is presented before the start of the first class of the entire show to the show office. Once the Vet slip is received, a \$40.00 office fee per entry and stall shall be deducted and a refund shall be mailed. Stalls are non refundable.

Fines Levied—Be aware that exhibitors are responsible for fines levied against the show caused by exhibitor. See Rule 414c in the AQHA Handbook.

NSF Fees—A \$35.00 NSF fee shall be added to all payment that are not sufficient.

Open Accounts—Accounts that are not settled before the end of the show shall incur an additional **\$25.00 collection fee**.

Accounts- Any questions on account billing must be asked with in 7 days of the shows completion. After that the accounts shall be considered settled.

Draws—All class draws shall be done at least two classes prior and posted on line. All late entries shall be placed at the discretion of the paddock manager.

Drug Testing—All horses entering APHA classes are subject to approved drug testing.

Walk Only—May cross enter into Leadline. No cross entry into Walk Trot Classes.

Walk/Trot—Please note that no cross entry is allowed between APHA Walk Trot and All Breed Walk Trot Canter.

All Breed—These classes are meant to encourage and bring new members to our association.

APHA Performance Halter—Horses one year of age and older. Horses are not eligible to compete in other classes as listed in APHA Rule SC-175 at the same show or contest. Horses must compete in a minimum of one performance class other than showmanship at the same show to be eligible. APHA Rule SC170 M1

APHA Ranch Class Exhibitors are not allowed to cross enter into Western Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle. Rule SC-302

Right to Service - The show management reserves the right to refuse service for any reason. This is a closed event and the management reserves the right to remove anyone from the grounds for any reason. Dogs are not allowed in the arena and schooling areas due to the extreme danger to injury to horse and riders.

Conditions—The conditions of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the APHA and WSPHC general rules. The final right to settle all questions or disputes is reserved for the show management. Exhibitors, Trainers, Riders or any other participant gives unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agrees in advance to be bound thereby. As condition of participation and or participation of my child I agree as follows: to release WSPHC, Evergreen State Fairgrounds, all employees, volunteers, agents and the show management of any loss or damage that may occur to me, my horses or my property as a result of my attendance or participation at this event. I am responsible for any loss, damages, or charges by me or my guest for the failure to follow posted rules, published facility or show rules. I will pay any bill rendered for such loss and damages. The final right to settle all questions and disputes is reserved for the show management. Exhibitors, trainers, riders and any other participants give unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agree in advance to be bound thereby

High Point Awards—Performance—All Classes in your division count **INCLUDING** halter. Please review high point standings posted on Saturday night and address any noted issues first thing Sunday morning by ten. Point to be on the sliding scale per number of horses shown with the maximum being 9 points. Ties will be broken in this order: Horse with most first, horse that places the most times, and last a flip of a coin. Hi points will be awarded 60 minutes after the completion of the show and once an audit by a show representative is complete. Awards must be picked up by eligible winners or a representative at the end of the show. Halter is not required to be eligible for your high point. You must show in three classes to be eligible for a high point. Any questions on high point standings must be addressed at the show within an a half hour of the last class, after that time all standings will remain as presented.

Hi Point Awards— Must show in 3 classes to qualify for a high point award

Novice Youth, Youth Walk Trot 5-10, Youth WT 11-18, Youth 13 and Under, Youth 18 and Under

All Breed 18 and Under, All Breed 19 and Over, All Breed Walk Trot

Novice Amateur, Amateur Walk Trot, Amateur 19 and Over, Master Amateur,

Open Horse, Green Horse, Ranch Horse

Hi Point Halter Awards- Only awarded to categories of official Championship Classes held with 3 or more entries in a Grand and Reserve class.

Halter, Open Stallions, Geldings, Mares
